



19+ Implementation Plan 2006 -7

Production of the over-arching 19+ Implementation Plan has been deferred for the duration of the Further Education Joint Review.

Ad interim, individual provider plans will work towards achievement of the targets set in the Lifelong Learning Strategy 2006-2021.

Collective actions to support and underpin individual provider actions will include:

- Shared promotion to raise aspirations (Celebrating Success pamphlet)
- Shared promotion to raise awareness of changes in qualifications (in progress in respect of new qualifications levels)
- Share all data and analysis for better informed planning (in progress)
- Support the establishment of a Thurrock CACHE registered centre (established)
- Raise the profile of adult learning (in progress through a number of routes including the new *Geton2Geton* learning bus)
- Work with the community and statutory stakeholders for the sustainability of the successful Community UK Online project – Technology Access Points.
- Obtain external funding for the continuance of the TLP Independent Adult Careers Guidance service (achieved)
- Work collaboratively with the Learning and Skills Council to improve work based learning provision in Thurrock (in progress)
- Continue to work with Thurrock Business Forum to ensure close links with employers to support their training needs, gain their input for development of new curriculum areas, work related learning, linkages with Sector Skills Councils and increase understanding between the business and learning and skills sectors (achieved and in progress).
- Engage with Lifelong Learning UK, the Sector Skills Council for all post 16 learning providers, which includes the voluntary sector and libraries, to include dissemination of new requirements and sharing the “learning curve” in meeting them (achieved and in progress)
- TLP to continue to be represented on the ACE Partnership Board and support the development and delivery of programmes for “On a Learning Curve” and generally to support the work of the community and voluntary sector in Thurrock (achieved and in progress)
- Work collaborative to develop more progression pathways (in progress)
- Support the further development of the Academy of Logistics and Transport with the long term ambition for it to become the hub for the Regional Skills Academy

- Collectively to be adaptable and flexible to be able to take advantage of new opportunities as they arise (in progress, eg, RoH and NSA developments; TLP hosted the BBC Raw Launch, Thurrock will be the focus for BBC Essex during Story Telling Festival week in Jan 2007. TLP will also host the NIACE Adult Learners Week Regional Awards Ceremony on 23 May 2007 – first time ever in the south of the region – also supports raising profile of adult education)
